Very importantly a **Bankers Order** form, if you wish to pay for future subscriptions and not worry about renewing every year and a **Gift Aid Declaration** form if you pay UK Tax.

On our website we have **NORS**, the "Norfolk Online Record Search", as a Member you are entitled to use this search facility, you will be contacted by Judith Parks (nors@nfhs.co.uk) within 4 weeks with your NORS I.D. and password.

Kirby Hall Library is open Tuesday, Thursday, 10am-1pm, Wednesday 10am-4pm, also the first and last Sunday of the month 10am-1pm. It is staffed by volunteer members who will always do their best to assist you, whether you telephone or visit in person. It may be possible for the Library to be opened on special request; this must be booked in advance.
